

Installing and running Millennium 3 with Windows 7 32bit or 64bit Operating Systems

The Millennium 3 (M3) payroll software is compatible with PC's installed with Microsoft Windows 7 as long as they are running an edition that supports XP Compatibility Mode. You can learn more about compatibility mode by searching Microsoft's website (www.Microsoft.com) for the keywords "XP Compatibility Mode".

Shown below are the current versions of Windows 7 which support XP Compatibility Mode.

- Windows 7 – Professional
- Windows 7 – Enterprise
- Windows 7 – Ultimate

Along with the latest release of the Millennium 3 software, native 64bit PDF drivers are now included for the "Millennium PDF" printer which means 64bit operating systems are also supported. For the database installation, both 32bit and 64bit SQLExpress 2008 and SQL Server 2008 are also supported as long as they are set up with "mixed mode authentication" enabled.

Considerations when installing and running M3

- When installing, the Millennium 3 software needs to register system files (.OCX and .DLL) which require the logged in user to have administrative privileges on the local machine. The user may need to be added to either the "Administrators" or "Power Users" group on the workstation for Millennium 3 to be installed correctly.
- With the addition of the UAC (*User Access Control*) in Windows 7 it is sometimes necessary, due to specific computer configurations, to allow files needed by Millennium 3 to be bypassed by the UAC. If necessary these settings can be configured in the Control Panel.
- In some instances the software executables (*Millennium.exe*, *PDFInstall.exe* and *ProcessServer.exe*) will need to be set to run in "Windows XP (Service Pack 3)" Compatibility mode under properties. This can be done by right clicking on the executable and choosing "Properties" and then the "Compatibility" tab.
- On computers with Adobe Reader X (*version 10*) installed it may display a prompt before opening up a previewed report. The prompt has a setting to "Always allow..." which must be checked in order for reports to open properly from the Millennium 3 software.
